

Citizens' Advisory Committees

Citizens' committees may be appointed by the Board of Education to perform specific duties or give general advice concerning school issues and activities. Some committees will be appointed as adjuncts to educational programs in order to comply with the regulations set forth by accrediting agencies or other governmental bodies.

1. The above referenced committees serve at the will of the board. They shall not assume duties or authority on any matters other than those explicitly defined by the board.
2. The board will accept recommendations for committee membership from subcommittees of the board, the administration, and former committee members, but all committee membership lists will be formally approved by the board at a regular meeting.
3. All committees, unless otherwise specified in their initial charge, will be dissolved and cease to function at the close of each school year.
4. All committees are to elect a chairperson and recording secretary, with such individuals being responsible for making timely progress reports to the board on the committee's activities and providing minutes of each meeting.
5. Meeting times and agendas will be coordinated through the superintendent's office.
6. Staff members may be assigned to participate on committees and are directed to cooperate in helping citizen committees carry out their assigned tasks.
7. Board members will be regarded as ex officio members of each citizens' committee, and individual board members may be designated as liaisons to the respective committees.
